Dear Parents/Guardians

Thank you for choosing The Salvation Army for your child's/children's summer camp the dates are June 4th – August 3rd 2018 and are hours of operation are 7am – 6pm. Below is just some information you might need to know about the camp.

Payments:

Here at The Salvation Army we charge the following amounts for our summer program

- 1 child \$60.00 per week
- 2 children \$115.00 per week
- 3 children \$140.00 per week
- 4 children \$165.00 per week.

Payments for day camp need to be made every Monday or by Tuesday morning at the latest any payments after that a late fee of \$15.00 will be charged. When making your payments we only accept the following payments **check or money order**. If any checks come back you will be charged the bank fees and you will no longer be able to pay by check

Picking up & Dropping Off:

The Camp opens at 7.00am and closes at 6.00pm; Parents must drop their child/children off by signing them in. Children are not allowed to walk here by themselves. Parents must also sign their child/children out when they arrive to pick them up. As mentioned before no child is allowed to walk here or leave here without a parent/guardian being with them.

Breakfast, Lunch & Snack:

The only meals The Salvation Army will be providing is lunch and snack you, the parent are responsible for breakfast. Lunch will be served at 11.45am and snack time is at 3.00pm. If you wish you can send them with a breakfast and they can eat it when they arrive.

Discipline:

Here at The Salvation Army your child will have to abide by our disciplinary procedure. If your child gets into trouble frequently he/she will be written up and if they continue to cause problems they will be asked to leave the camp. Things that are **NOT** tolerated are bullying, Disrespect to staff and other campers, Starting fights, name calling and cursing.

Swimming:

Every Tuesday & Thursday we will be taking the children swimming. If your child does not know how to swim the pool requires them to wear a life jacket which you the parent have to provide. Floaties are not allowed. Children who are able to swim will be required to take a swim test. If they do not pass they will have to stay in the shallow end. Cost of swimming is \$2.00 per child.

Field Trips:

During the summer we will be going on various field trips, Parents are expected to pay for their child's field trips, if for any reason your child cannot go on the field trips he/she will have to stay home for the day. A field trip schedule will be given to you on the first day of summer stating how much the field trip will be and where we will be going. Payment for the field trips must be in cash. While on The Field trips the children must wear their Salvation Army Shirt they are given at the beginning of the summer camp at all times.

Accidents:

Unfortunately children are children and accidents will happen, if your child receives any bumps we will apply to ice to stop any swelling and if your child cuts themselves we clean cut and apply a band aid. We will also write the incident up and you will be asked to sign it so we can keep it on file. If the accident is more serious you will be contacted straight away to pick up your child. Please make sure all contact name and numbers are correct when filling out the application.

Vacations:

If you decide to take your child on vacation during the summer program, you will have to pay half your weekly fee to keep their space open for the time that your child/children will be out of the program.
