

Clearwater Business and Housing

Diversity is the key to Clearwater's business community – tourism, manufacturing,

healthcare services and trade all contribute to the economy. A strong school system and higher education opportunities provide a well-paid, educated work force to serve area businesses.

By taking full advantage of the area's many strengths and resources, residents and visitors will find North Pinellas County a better place to live, work and play.

Housing is affordable in Upper Pinellas County. Condos range from the low 40's and up. Average single family home prices are in the range of \$120,000. Florida residents are eligible for a Homestead Exemption (a \$25,000 reduction in taxable assessed value) for real estate taxes. Another advantage is that Florida



does not have a state income tax at this time.

The communities of Largo, Dunedin, Safety Harbor, Palm Harbor, and Clearwater Beach are also convenient to the Corps.

Recreation and the Arts

The Bay Area offers outstanding recreational opportunities and a wide variety of options to enjoy the arts. Whether it is a day trip to Disney, a trip to the aquarium, a visit to a museum, or a night at the symphony, one will never grow bored because of a lack of available things to do.
